PROTOCOL FOR VISITING HOURS IN HOSPITALS DURING THE COVID-19

With South Africa's confirmed COVID-19 cases increasing daily, the Department of health Limpopo deems fit to change thing as another way of reducing the risk of the coronavirus, there is a need to limit access to hospitals premises.

It is against this backround that the protocols of visiting patients are adjusted as follows:

1. VISITING HOURS:

1.1 Visiting hours will be limited to one hour per day from 12h00 - 13h00, with effect from Thursday 19 March 2020.

2. NUMBER OF VISITORS PER PATIENT:

- 2.1 A maximum of two visitors per day.
- 2.2 One visitor to be allowed at the bedside at a time and such a visitor cannot spend more than 15 min with the patient.
- 3. Any other visits outside the prescribed period will be authorized by the attending doctor and prior arrangements should have been made.
- 4. These measures will be applicable until further notice.
- 5. Your cooperation in this regard will be much appreciated.
