Limpopo Department of Health is saddened by the untimely death of a 30 years old Percy Machubeni an Oral Hygienist who was stationed at Donald Fraser Hospital. Mr Machubeni started working in Donald Fraser Hospital from 01 October 2012 until when he met his untimely death on Thursday evening of the 3rd June 2021 in a motor vehicle accident that claimed his life, that of his wife and of his 2 children on the N1 road around Louis Trichardt area.

MEC Ramathuba says the death of Percy Machubeni is a great loss to the department and the health fraternity at large. "We are devastated by the passing on of Mr Machubeni one of our Oral Hygienist who had dedicated his life to serve and change the lives of his community. The pain is worsened by three more lives from one family being lost at the same time. May the memories of his wonderful personality and contributions be celebrated.
